




Lavender Berry Beautiful






This is a compact perennial with attractive, almost rounded light green leaves producing an abundance of intense bright red blossoms that are excellent for pots, rockeries, containers or beds.

SPINACH NZ Warrigal Greens

Spinach NZ Warrigal Greens is a spreading, native bush tucker alternative to spinach. Leaves have a mild flavour, similar to spinach. Ideal for use in pesto, stir fries, soups, and stews.



SNOW PEA Bikini

Snow Pea Bikini is a vigorous variety that requires little support, producing sweet, flat, crisp, IOcm long pods. Ideal in salads, stir fries and Asian cuisine. A good source of dietary fibre, protein and iron.



HONEYDEW Melon

Honeydew Melon is an easy to grow melon. This white skinned variety is round/oval in shape, has smooth skin, and weighs I.8-2kg. Combine with other seasonal fruit for great fruit salads, eat with icecream or eat fresh.



ROCKMELON

Rockmelon produces medium to large, oval shaped fruit with sweet orange flesh. Fruit has a firm rind, with a light rib and can grow up to 18cm in diameter and weigh up to 2kg. Combine with other seasonal fruit for great fruit salads, eat with icecream or eat fresh.



TOMATO Sugar Snack

Tomato Sugar Snack bears high yields of extra sweet cherry tomatoes that melt in your mouth. Great for salads, sandwiches or as a garnish. Tomatoes are a good source of Vitamin C and some Vitamin A and should only be refrigerated when over-ripe.



CUCUMBER Patio

Cucumber Patio is specifically bred for patio and pot gardening. The neat, compact plant produces high yields of deep green 15-20cm fruit. Pick regularly to encourage more fruit. Can be used for pickling, salads and sandwiches.



CAPSICUM Big Bertha

Capsicum Big Bertha produces sweet, large fruit that ripens from green to red. Use in cooked dishes, on pizza, in salads and stir fries. Capsicums are full of antioxidants.





Strawberry Sweetheart is an alpine type with white flowers bearing large, deep red, sweet fruit. Best eaten fresh, you can also use in jams, tarts, ice cream, fruit salads and smoothies. Strawberries can be frozen but lose most of their nutritional value.

Hidden Valley Herbed Butter



Ingredients

- 250gms salted butter
- 1 tbspn chopped parsley 1 tbspn chopped basil
- 1 tbspn chopped sage
- 1 tbspn chopped thyme
- 1 tbspn chopped red chilli zest of one lemon finely grated

Soften butter then place in a large bowl and mix the remainder of ingredients in the butter. Place on a sheet of baking paper and roll into a log shape and refrigerate for 1 hour. Cut into discs and place on top of your favourite steak 2 minutes before you serve.

MINT Chocolate

The aromatic bronze green foliage combines the uplifting aroma of peppermint with the irresistible fragrance of chocolate. Great for drinks, salads, desserts, sauces, ice cream, cakes, garnishes or use to flavour tea and coffee.

THAI BASIL

Thai basil has a spicy licorice basil flavour and aroma. Great in Vietnamese and Thai cuisine, curries, tomato dishes, pasta sauces, vegetables and soups. Can also be used in herbal teas.

TARRAGON

A popular kitchen herb with upright stems bearing shiny narrow green leaves. The delicate anise taste of the leaves is a handy addition to many dishes. Used to flavour fish, poultry and cheese dishes.

ROSEMARY

The fragrant, evergreen leaves are extremely high in iron, calcium and Vitamin B6. Use in Mediterranean cuisine, lamb, fish, vegetables, meat, soups, stews, rice, jam, jellies and biscuits. Can also be used in herbal tea.

CORIANDER Slow Bolt

Otherwise known as 'Cilantro' or Chinese Parsley, Coriander has a fragrance reminiscent of citrus peel. Both the leaves and seed collected from the plant can be used for culinary purposes. Use leaves in sauces, soups, curries, salads and meats, seeds can be used

in stews, ham, pork, Indian Cuisine and pickles
